Alcohol and Party Risk Management Workshops - Mondays 6:30-7:30pm (or by appt) – Tang Center

Peer-led, interactive 1-hour workshops designed to increase “best practice” of alcohol and party risk management. Designed for licensees, managers, and employees, LEAD provides effective and educational training on alcohol responsibility and California law. Successful completion of LEAD training fulfills the MANDATORY requirement for Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) training for alcohol retailers in Berkeley (BMC Section 9.84.030)
