The following tips have been brought to you by the Local Affairs Office in Associated Students. Please consider this important information, also available online at ucsbhalloween.com, as you celebrate Halloween 2011 in IV this year and remember to keep Halloween a LOCAL event.

A message from UCSB Transportation & Parking Services:

All vehicles affected by the Isla Vista road closures must be moved to campus with the valid Annual Night/Weekend parking permit (DP and the north/south streets south of Trigo) by 3:00 on Friday, October 28.

All UCSB students affected by the Isla Vista road closures with the Annual Night/Weekend parking permits will be directed to park only in the following lots/structures: Lot 16, 18 Mesa Structure & 22 Parking Structure

UCSB undergrad students are eligible to purchase a Night/Weekend Permit valid throughout the entire academic year. These permits are only available online at: www.tps.ucsb.edu. Permits cost \$52.50 each, and shipping costs \$5.95. Be sure to purchase your permit by October 17, to ensure it will be mailed to you in time for Halloween! Temporary permits will not be honored on campus during the Halloween weekend parking restriction.

Vehicles parked on campus without the proper permit are subject to a \$300 citation and/or impound at the vehicle owner's expense.

We're here to serve YOU! It is critical that you keep yourself informed as Halloween approaches. Make sure to check our website (listed below) periodically for updates and new information.

- Two medical tents will be available. There will be a first aid/minor injury station located at St. Athanasius Church (across the street from Pita Pit on Embarcadero Del Mar). There will also be an EMERGENCY ONLY tent near IV Theater.
- The Festival Ordinance will be in place from 10/27-11/5 from 6pm to 7am each day. Violating this ordinance could cost you a \$500 fine or even jail time, or both!
